RSVP Required! Zero Tally Results Display

On Saturday October 15, Candidates and/or your scrutineers are invited to attend a zero tally results display before voting opens. This will take place at **9 AM in the Council Chambers** at the Municipal Offices (395 Mulock Drive). Only 1 person per candidate is allowed to be present for this display – either a candidate or scrutineer.

Voter Instruction Letters



Voters who are on the Voters' List should receive their Voter Instruction Letters in the mail by the end of this week. If a voter does not receive their letter, they are not on the Municipal Voters' List or the letter may still be in the mail.

There is still time for qualified voters to get on the list by:

- Using the easy [online tool](#) until 6 PM on October 24
- Visiting the Municipal Offices (395 Mulock Drive) in person and speaking with a Customer Service representative during regular business hours:
- Attending in person at any [Voter Assistance Centre](#) from October 15 to 24

Voters who are adding themselves to the Voters' List will need to provide [acceptable identification](#) that shows their name and Newmarket address.

Voting Opens This Saturday

Voting opens this weekend – **Saturday, October 15, 2022 at 10 AM**. We ask that you remind voters that as long as they have their Voter Instruction Letter, they can vote from anywhere they have an internet connection (i.e., home, work, etc.). With

10 full days of voting, they can submit their ballot from **anywhere**, at **anytime** starting at **10 AM on October 15 and ending at 8 PM on October 24**. There is no reason to wait to the last minute to vote on October 24.

Voters who do not have access to an internet-connected device, or would like assistance with online voting, can visit one of two Voter Assistance Centres at the **Magna Centre** and the **Ray Twinney Recreation Complex**. Both will be open from **10 AM to 8 PM** each day of the voting period. Unstaffed computer terminals are available during the voting period for voters at the **Newmarket Public Library** (438 Park Ave.) during regular business hours and at the **Seniors' Meeting Place** (474 Davis Drive), Monday to Friday, 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM

If a voter needs help voting but need to stay home, they can call 905-953-5152 to book an appointment and members of the Election Street Team can visit their home to assist the voter with voting.

Voters wishing to vote in-person by paper ballot may do so by appointment during the 10-day voting period at the Town of Newmarket Municipal Office (395 Mulock Drive) only. Hours of operation are 10 AM. to 8 PM from October 15 to October 24. Appointments for paper ballot voting can be made by calling (905) 953-5152.

Special Voting Locations

Election staff will be at the following special voting locations during the 10 voting days.

The exact location of Election Staff within the facility is subject to change. Check newmarketvotes.ca for any updates.

Candidates and their teams wishing to visit these locations are required to follow

health, safety, and campaigning protocols set by each location.

These locations are intended only for residents who are **living** in the facilities and are not for the general public.

At home Voter Assistance with the Election Street Team

The Election Street Team will visit the homes of voters who require at-home voting assistance to help them cast their ballot. Voters who require this service can call the Elections Office at 905-953-5152 and **book an appointment** with a member of the Elections Team. This service will be offered during the 10-day voting period, from **Saturday, October 15 to Monday, October 24**.

Candidates are encouraged to communicate this service to voters who may benefit from this service. Candidates **should not** be visiting residents' homes to get them to vote on the spot!
