Important Information

- This Voting PIN has been assigned to, and may only be used by, the voter in this letter.
- By using the online voting system and entering your assigned Voting PIN, you are declaring that you are eligible to vote in the 2022 Newmarket Municipal Election.
- It is against the law to vote more than once in Newmarket or vote without being eligible to do so.

You are eligible to vote if:

- You are at least 18 years of age on October 24, 2022;
- You are a Canadian citizen;
- You or your spouse lives, rents or owns property in the Town of Newmarket; and,
- You are not otherwise prohibited from voting by law.
